QUESTIONS

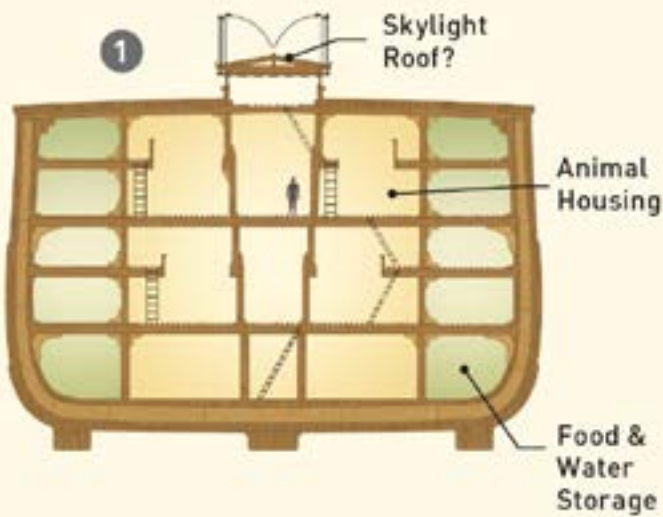
- Because of sin, we experience both God's judgment and God's grace. **Where do you see God's judgment and grace in Noah's story?**
